1. Describe your ideal practice.
 - a. Where (city and state) is your ideal practice located?
 - b. What kind of patients would you most like to work with?
 - b. How many patient visits per hour/ day / week would you like to see?
 - c. How much time would you like to spend with each patient?
 - d. How much money would you like to earn per month / year if all overhead costs are covered?
 - e. How many treatment rooms would you like to use simultaneously?
 - f. What do you expect out of us?
2. What is the best way to generate the kind of practice that you want? What strategies or structures do you think are required in order to bring your ideal practice into existence?
3. Why are you interested in working with us? What do we have to offer that you think will further the kind of practice that you want to have?
4. Why, in your estimation have you not created your ideal clinic yet?
5. Why do we want to work with you? What qualities or assets do you bring that will enrich the success of your practice and that of the Rising Lotus Wellness Center?
6. Do you know how to operate Quick Books and Microsoft Outlook Software?
7. What are areas that need work for you?
8. What State (s) do you currently hold a license?
